(ii) What are the chances that any rod selected will be 15 meters length or above?
- Q.5.a) The mean life time of electric light bulbs produced by a company has in the past been 1120 hours with a standard deviation of 125 hours. A sample of 100 electric light bulbs recently chosen showed a mean lifetime of 1095 hours. Test the hypothesis that the mean lifetime of bulbs has not changed i.e.  $H_0: \mu = 1120$  using 5% level of significance.
  - b) Given two random samples of size  $n_1 = 9$ ,  $n_2 = 16$ , from two independent normal populations with

$$\overline{X}_1 = 75$$
,  $\overline{X}_2 = 60$ ,  $S_1 = 13.61$ ,  $S_2 = 11.05$  Test  $H_0: \mu_1 = \mu_2$  against  $H_1: \mu_1 > \mu_2$ . Assume that the populations have unequal variances.
